Activities & Visits - 2021

Update on our delivery of items to our various Charity Partners since Lockdown was announced on 22nd March'20.

December 2020:

- > Prabartak Sangha -- Organised delivery of critical medicines , groceries and food items for their 52 inmates.
- > Balwadi Creche -- Organised delivery of Track Suits for their 47 children.

From one such response one Ms Ira Asthana sent a monetary contribution of Rs 20000 direct to Asha Niketan bank account. Her commitment to the cause of children suffering from Spastic cerebral palsy leading to Intellectual disability is very much appreciated . Another friend of ours viewing our Portal came forward to donate Rs 10000 to Welfare Society for the Blind in December.

January 2021:

- > Asha Niketan -- Organised delivery of groceries , cleaning materials and Mosquito repellents . .
 - > Shishu Kalyan School -- They too required monthly groceries , food items and few cleaning items for the School. These were delivered in the School..
- You can also find moments of hope and resilience all around us despite the uncertainty . Many of our friends and Corporates like Acer India Pvt Ltd have come forward to support our cause for additional support to few of our small NGO Partners that we support ...

Acer India came forward to support the educational & mid day meal expenses (Rs 1.25 lakh) for 25 of their children-- thank you so much for this act of benevolence from Acer India and for being a true friend and a huge support to our cause ...

Similarly our juniors from SPHS -- members of ' Pointers Who Care' came forward to support the purchase of critical medicines required for 55 inmates of Prabartak Sangha (home for Orphanage) out of which 33 of them suffer from severe epilepsy.

February 2021:

- > Balwadi Creche -- Supply of Exercise Books / Study Books / Crayons for 93 students of Nursery and KG class.
- > Prabartak Sangha -- Monthly Groceries for their 55 inmates.

March 2021:

- > W.B.S. (Welfare Society for the Blind) by providing Covid related hygiene items as required by them.
- > Old Age Home at All Bengal Women's Union -- provided them with monthly groceries and food items.

April 2021:

- > Anandan School -- Supplied food items and groceries required for the month for all their students.
- > Pushpamoyee School -- Supplied food items and groceries required for the month for all their students
- > PRAYAAS - They are mainly into infrastructure development for Medical facilities and Education . Since they need higher financial support we agreed to support them once in the year (accumulating our committed support to them for the year) with our limited resource .

Our friend, Pravin Bharatiya helped our cause by arranging the monthly Medicine requirement of Prabartak Sangha, home for orphanages for the month of April.

We from South Point 66 Social Welfare Society also arranged for Subha Nabarsha (Bengali New Year) lunch for two of our support Partners --- for our elderly sisters of Old Age Home and for the young children of Prabartak Sangha , home for Orphanage.

May 2021:

- > Shishu Kalyan School: Delivered food items , exercise books , various school stationery for their students.
- > Asha Niketan : Delivered monthly groceries for their inmates and day
- > We from South Point 66 Social Welfare Society also supported part of the Hospital charges from our GBS fund for Kirti Das ,a student of Anandan School who had to undergo a major Brain surgery.
- > Our friend Ranojay & Godhuli Banerjee made arrangement to supply emergency monthly medicine requirement for Prabartak Sangha inmates who suffer from severe epilepsy. These gestures from friends keep us motivated to persist with our VISION of Helping , Healing and Caring.
- > Organised to deliver 80 nos PPE Kits to Pratibandhi Sammilani a new 25 Bed care center for Covid patients from our Society fund . This care center is located at Mukundapur , Kolkata - 700099.
- > Our Society has pledged 1 nos Oxygen Concentrator of 5 ltr capacity to Humanity Trust Hospital located at Joka.

June 2021:

- > Prabartak Sangha - Delivered Food items, Stationeries and Electrical items for their 52 inmates
- > Balwadi Creche - Delivered Vitamin Tablets and ORS to meet the monthly requirement of their 70 children
- > Mira Upkar Trust - Delivered special educational materials for their children with learning disabilities to develop analytical and reasonable thinking. Gave items like STEM Toys, Treatment materials for DYSLEXIA CHILDREN, Sensory stimulation toys, Memory developing toys, Physiotherapy Peanut Ball, Speech based fun toys etc.

We also received Medicines for the month of June'21 for 52 inmates of Prabartak Sangha, sponsored by our friend Rtn. Sudipta Ghosh, Rotary Club of Belvedere Gardens, Kolkata. Such noble gestures from our friends keeps us moving ahead in our GBS journey.

July 2021:

- > Welfare Society for the Blind -- Paid their half yearly Computers Maintenance charges
- > Old Age Home (ABWU) -- Delivered their monthly requirements of Medicines , Groceries and 10 kg of Mangoes (langra)
- > Prabartak Sangha -- Emergency medicines as required for their 52 inmates were delivered . Our friend Sudipta Ghosh organised to donate these medicines.

August 2021:

- > Anandan School for slum children : Supplied various eatables for the students for next two months.

> Pushpamoyee School for slum children : Groceries and food items for students and their family for the month.

> Prabartak Sangha -- supplied critical medicines for all their inmates (Sponsored by our friend Pravin Bharatiya)
